Aflatoxins are naturally occurring mycotoxins produced by two species of the fungi *Aspergillus* and are known to be genotoxic and carcinogenic. Aflatoxins can occur in foods such as groundnuts, treenuts, corn, rice, figs and other dried foods, wheat, spices and crude vegetable oils, as a result of fungal contamination before and after harvest. They can also be found in feedstocks for agricultural animals which have the potential to pass the toxins into eggs and milk products.

Copperhead confirms that based on knowledge of our manufacturing processes and assurances from our raw material suppliers, we consider SDM<sup>®</sup>27 to be free of the above potential allergens and aflatoxins.
